

SOLID CORE® NO-NONSENSE LIFETIME WARRANTY

SOLID CORE SIDING® offers a complete, exterior siding system, combining superior energy efficiency with durable, long-lasting beauty. Its tough Vycralar™ surface is fused with SOLID CORE™ backing, creating a product with unmatched bridge strength, superior R-values and air infiltration ratings, and guaranteed impact resistance. These exceptional qualities allow SOLID CORE SIDING to be backed by the industry's only No-Nonsense Lifetime Warranty.

The manufacturer warrants to the homeowner that SOLID CORE SIDING will not peel, blister, pit, flake or corrode as a result of manufacturing defects or as a result of exposure to ocean air (salt spray).

Unlike conventional veneer-type sidings, which are warranted only to the initial homeowner, SOLID CORE SIDING is warranted for the lifetime of the house — the period for which the structural integrity of the house remains intact.

In order to transfer this warranty, the new homeowner can simply return the transfer card within 30 days of the transfer of ownership of the house.

In case of "commercial" installations — such as apartment buildings, condominiums, etc. — the period of warranty coverage shall be 60 years.

1. UNIFORM WEATHERING The manufacturer warrants that SOLID CORE SIDING will weather in a uniform manner and that weathering changes will not occur on a specific wall exposure in a manner that varies from panel to panel (checkerboard effect).

2. DEGREE OF WEATHERING For the lifetime the original homeowner owns and lives in the home, SOLID CORE SIDING is warranted not to change color in excess of 4 standard industry color units.

3. HIGH IMPACT RESISTANCE Our tests have demonstrated that SOLID CORE SIDING is 300% more resistant to cracking than conventional hollow-backed sidings. Should SOLID CORE SIDING panels crack for reasons associated with normal home ownership (for example, hail damage), the manufacturer will replace all damaged panels, including the cost of material and labor, which exceeds the amount covered by the homeowner's insurance policy. Proof of submission and resolution from the homeowner's insurance company (and promptly following the warranty procedure below) are required before final settlement of the claim.

4. COVERAGE AGAINST CHALKING Our SOLID CORE SIDING panels are produced with an exclusive Vycralar™ formulation featuring treated TiO₂, and are warranted not to chalk in an offensive manner that could cause discoloration of trim areas.

5. COVERAGE AGAINST SEPARATION Fusion technology ensures the structural integrity of our SOLID CORE SIDING panels, therefore, our panels will not separate so as to negatively affect the performance of the product.

6. WIND RESISTANCE Our tests have demonstrated that SOLID CORE SIDING will withstand the equivalent of 130 mph windloads, without damage, when installed correctly. If winds up to 130 mph cause a

panel to separate from the structure, the manufacturer will replace any damaged panels — including the cost of material and labor.

7. PRODUCT INTEGRITY Our SOLID CORE SIDING has been tested extensively by us in freeze, thaw and heat cycles to ensure proper panel performance. Therefore, when properly installed, should SOLID CORE SIDING panels buckle for reasons associated with expansion or contraction, the manufacturer will replace the damaged product — including the cost of material and labor.

8. MOISTURE PROTECTION All expanded polystyrene material used in the production of SOLID CORE SIDING has been tested to a Perm Rating of 5. The product will breathe and is warranted not to retain moisture.

9. MAKING A WARRANTY CLAIM Within a reasonable time after discovery of a suspected manufacturing defect, you should communicate with the installing contractor, briefly explaining your complaint. The contractor, after personal inspection, should register the complaint with the manufacturer's Warranty Service Department at the address listed on this Warranty document. The manufacturer will then investigate the claim and examine the material claimed to be defective. If a defect covered by this Warranty is confirmed, the manufacturer, within a reasonable time after the inspection, will repair or replace (at manufacturer's option) the SOLID CORE SIDING product — including the cost of material and labor. In the case of an impact resistance claim, you must contact the - manufacturer's warranty service department before any replacement installation work begins.

10. ITEMS NOT COVERED BY WARRANTY This Warranty does not cover damage or defect caused by settlement or shifting of structural members or adjoining surfaces, structural defects of the building, fire, wind, flood, lightning or other acts of God (except those specifically warranted against in this Warranty document), intentional acts and unreasonable use, accident, negligence, exposure to harmful chemicals, pollutants, mildew — or airborne stains. Improper installation of SOLID CORE SIDING product renders all Warranty coverage null and void. The installation of accessory products — which are either inherently incompatible with the product covered by this Warranty, or which are installed in a manner detrimental to the good performance of SOLID CORE SIDING — will render this Warranty null and void.

11. LIMITATIONS THERE ARE NO EXPRESS WARRANTIES EXCEPT AS CONTAINED IN THIS WARRANTY. ORAL STATEMENTS DO NOT CONSTITUTE WARRANTIES.

THE MANUFACTURER'S LIABILITIES ARE LIMITED SOLELY AND EXCLUSIVELY TO THE OBLIGATIONS SPECIFICALLY UNDERTAKEN HEREIN AND (EXCEPT AND ONLY TO THE EXTENT THIS LIMITATION IS SPECIFICALLY PRECLUDED BY APPLICABLE LAW OF MANDATORY APPLICATION) DO NOT INCLUDE ANY LIABILITY FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR OTHER DAMAGES OF ANY KIND WHATSOEVER, WHETHER ANY CLAIM IS BASED UPON THEORIES OF CONTRACT, NEGLIGENCE, OR TORT.

Some States do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.
